Requirements:

For approval by ACLM to be a Full Academic Pathway university program, the following criteria must be met:

- An ACLM approved Partial Academic Pathway is already in place
- At least one faculty is a DipACLM, DipABLM, and/or DipIBLM
- · An active Lifestyle Medicine Student Interest Group in place
- Assignment and completion of the Foundations of Lifestyle Medicine Board Review Course within the curriculum
